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Understanding what OAA is?

Students will focus on: researching different types of outdoor adventurous activities considering where they can be done safely and effectively.

The Benefits of OAA

Students will focus on: planning and taking part in an outdoor adventurous activity safely and effectively, developing their skills and thinking about the wider benefits of people taking part in these activities.

Performance and Leadership

Students will focus on: showing development of skills in specific sports, using sports leadership skills to plan and lead other students safely and effectively.

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Issues which Affect Participation in Sport

Students will focus on: learning why some people take part in physical activity but others don't, considering how we can help the user groups that don't and why some sports are more popular than others in the UK.

The Role of Sport in Promoting Values

Students will focus on: learning what values and behaviours are important in sport, considering why do some performers choose to cheat and use drugs and why some countries want to host major sports events.

National Governing Bodies and Technology

Students will focus on: learning how sport is organised 'behind-the-scenes' and how technology impacts sport.
