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Sweets

Students will complete observational drawings inspired by the formal elements of art, looking at the artist Sarah Graham.

Everyday Objects

Students will complete digital drawings inspired by a collection of— items looking at the artist Michael Craig Martin.

Urban Landscape

Students will take their own photographs, and work over the top with physical manipulation, collage and paint techniques.



SCAN ME

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Portraiture

Students will develop accurate drawing skills to explore portraiture alongside looking at a variety of different artists and techniques. Artists include Julian Opie, Giacometti, Marion Bolognesi.

Art History

Students will learn about the history of art, and focus on exploring several different defining art movements from over the past 2000 years.

Seascapes

Students will explore the artist Kurt Jackson and create their own seascapes inspired by our local coastline.

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Tonal Illusions

Students will explore developing form using a variety of tonal values with a limited colour palette. The artist studied will be Picasso.

Insects

Students will create beautiful observational drawings of insects, which they will develop into prints and repeat patterns inspired by EA Seguy.

Architecture

Students will create their own photoshoot of buildings around the school site, then turn them into digital monochrome paintings inspired by Henrique Folster.

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Nature

Students will explore a variety of different art techniques based on the theme of nature. They will complete their own photos and produce drawings and paintings on this theme.

Structures

Students will explore the idea of mixed media, print, collage and painting inspired by Ian Murphy and Sunga Park.

Personal Portfolio

Students will be given a variety of six different themes. They will choose one theme and, research artists, techniques and ideas inspired by that theme.

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Personal Portfolio

Students will continue to develop their personal project exploring their chosen theme. They will be working towards developing ideas for an outcome.

Externally Set Assignment

Students will be given an exam paper from Eduqas with 15 different themes. Each student will complete a project based on ONE of the themes.

Final Exam

Students will sit their final 10 hour exam. This is the deadline for all coursework and exam units.
