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The Norman Conquest and Control of England

Students will consider: why the Battle of Hastings was a key turning point in our history and how did William gain control.

Medieval Life

Students will consider: how powerful were the Medieval Monarchs and why were women ignored in this period. They will also explore challenges Medieval people faced.

The Making of the UK

Students will focus on: a study of the decisions made by the Tudor and Stuart monarchs, considering how they still have an effect on our lives today.

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Slavery and The British Empire

Students will focus on: a study of how and why millions of Africans were transported to the Americas and how this has implications in Britain today as well as the impact the British had both now and then.

Impact of Enlightenment and The Industrial Revolution

Students will focus on: the impact of the Age of Reason when tradition was challenged; the resulting American and French Revolutions and why Britain became the richest country in the 19th century.

Local Study and Protest and Democracy

Students will focus on: exploring the rich history of Cornwall through the importance of mining to this area, the history of protest and the fight to get the vote.

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World War I

Students will focus on: the cause, events and consequences of the Great War, considering why it was a world war and how new ideas in 20th century led to WWII.

WWII and Conflicts Since 1945

Students will focus on: the cause, events and consequences of the Second World War including an extended study of the Holocaust; conflicts since 1945 including the Cold War and terrorism.

Genocide in the 20th Century

Students will consider: why do human beings not learn from history? They also study genocides post WWII.

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Medicine in Britain c1250- the Present Day.

Students will focus on: how and why ideas about the cause, treatment and prevention of disease have changed from the Medieval period to the present day.

Medicine in WWI and Germany 1918-1938

Students will consider: how conflict leads to progress in medicine; Germany from the end of WWI to the beginning of WWII, including the recovery of Germany; the rise of the Nazis and life in Nazi Germany.

Germany 1918-1939

Students will focus on: a continuing study of Germany, focusing on life in Nazi Germany.

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Anglo-Saxon Norman England c1060-c1088

Students will focus on: the study of Anglo-Saxon England just before the Norman invasion, the Norman conquest and control of Anglo-Saxon England and the Normanisation of England.

Revision

Students will focus on: revising and consolidating their understanding of key topics in preparation for their upcoming examinations.

Superpower Relations: The Cold War c1943-c1991

Students will focus on: the development of the Cold War between the USA and the USSR, the major crises in this period, finishing with the end of the Cold War.
